

# Staffordshire Cycle Ride



Charlie Bagot Jewitt, Staffordshire High Sheriff 2020, will be setting out to cycle around his 'bailiwick' (the County of Staffordshire) from 1 to 9 Aug 2020. This will be in aid of the Staffordshire Community Foundation <https://staffsfoundation.org.uk>.

Charlie hopes to be accompanied by a 'posse' of 6 to 10 cyclists but anyone is welcome to join in for as far as they want. If you join us, Charlie would ask that you set up a giving page and raise money the Community Foundation.

There will be a launch day on Staffordshire Day (Fri 1 May 2020) including a photocall and a short ride around the town.

The provisional programme for the  300 mile ride is:

Sat 1 Aug Blithfield Hall WS15 3NL to Chillington Hall via County Hall Stafford (on canals)

Sun 2 Chillington to Chillington via Kinver Edge and the 'panhandle' behind Wolverhampton (part canal part corkscrew lane)

Mon 3 Chillington to Mucklestone via Norbury Junction (largely canal)

Tue 4 Mucklestone to Basford Hall via Stoke on Trent (road then canal)

Weds 5 Basford Hall to Hartington YHA via The Roaches/Flash highest village in England (Roads - hills!)

Thu 6 Hartington to Uttoxeter via Manifold Valley Cycle , Weaver Hills and Roston(track/roads).

Fri 7 Uttoxeter to Thorpe Constantine via Burton on Trent (road/canal)

Sat 8 Thorpe Constantine to Blithfield via Lichfield Cathedral (road/canal)

The ride will take in many of the best tourist attractions and sites in Staffordshire
